MATCHING GRANTS

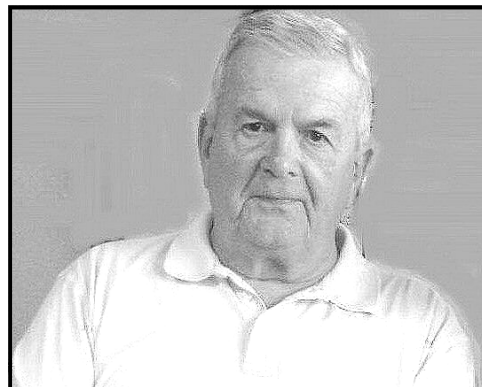
Many companies offer matching grants to non-profit organizations, such as the Friends of the Arlington Public Library.

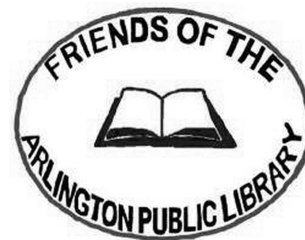
