



GET A LIFELINE TO AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY

Affordable service remains a challenge for many low-income consumers. The Lifeline program is a federal FCC program that helps increase access to these services by offering a monthly discount of up to \$9.25 off your phone or Internet service. You can qualify based on your annual income or if anyone in your home receives:

- SNAP
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefits

FREE PUBLIC Wi-Fi @ YOUR LIBRARY

The Arlington Public Library continues to offer free Wi-Fi at all library locations, no username or password required.

Bring your own device or use a public device at any library locations. Public computer access requires a library card or the purchase of a guest pass (\$1).

Dedicated educational and internet computers are available for children, equipped with filtering software providing age appropriate access.

Accessing the library's Wi-Fi requires you to follow the Arlington Public Library Computer Use policy, available on our website.

Drop by any location near you to hop on and surf the Internet in the comfort of your local library.

The City's Smart Lighting and Neighborhood Wi-Fi project provides free public Wi-Fi for people living in East Arlington. This resource ensures that citizens in this neighborhood receive connectivity services.
