<p><b>READ</b></p> <p>A favorite story again and again. How can you make each time different?</p>	<p><b>WRITE</b></p> <p>Lace beads on string</p>	<p><b>SING</b></p> <p>Sing a counting song such as <i>Hickory Dickory Dock</i> or <i>Five Little Monkeys</i></p>	<p><b>TALK</b></p> <p>Talk about a favorite food. What makes it so tasty?</p>	<p><b>PLAY</b></p> <p>Use cups, buckets or bowls to play with sand, dirt, and water</p>	<p><b>ART</b></p> <p>Create a mural on sidewalk with chalk</p>
<p><b>READ</b></p> <p>During mealtime, read books about fruits and vegetables</p>	<p><b>WRITE</b></p> <p>Make marks in sand or shaving cream</p>	<p><b>SING</b></p> <p>Clap and/or stomp while singing or listening to music</p>	<p><b>TALK</b></p> <p>Watch the traffic go by and describe the vehicles- red car, garbage truck, etc.</p>	<p><b>PLAY</b></p> <p>Go outside- jump into puddles and piles of leaves, collect rocks</p>	<p><b>ART</b></p> <p>Tape paper on wall and allow scribble time</p>
<p><b>READ</b></p> <p>Read some books about different animals</p>	<p><b>WRITE</b></p> <p>Roll, squish, and mash play dough</p>	<p><b>SING</b></p> <p>Sing <i>Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star</i> or <i>Itsy-Bitsy Spider</i></p>	<p><b>TALK</b></p> <p>Discover textures and talk about how they feel</p>	<p><b>PLAY</b></p> <p>Blow bubbles and try to catch them</p>	<p><b>ART</b></p> <p>Trace your child's hand or feet onto a piece of paper and let your child color it</p>
<p><b>READ</b></p> <p>Share books with "lift the flaps"</p>	<p><b>WRITE</b></p> <p>Pick up different sized objects with tongs</p>	<p><b>SING</b></p> <p>Sing a song that mentions different body parts</p>	<p><b>TALK</b></p> <p>Take a walk and talk about the things you see</p>	<p><b>PLAY</b></p> <p>Sort stuffed animals by color, size, shape</p>	<p><b>ART</b></p> <p>Make a collage from bits of old magazines or gift wrap!</p>
<p><b>READ</b></p> <p>Read about something fluffy</p>	<p><b>WRITE</b></p> <p>Roll a ball – try it with both left hand and right hand</p>	<p><b>SING</b></p> <p>Sing or say a favorite nursery rhyme</p>	<p><b>TALK</b></p> <p>Talk about different kinds of birds and what sounds they make</p>	<p><b>PLAY</b></p> <p>Play dress-up and let your child tell you what he is</p>	<p><b>ART</b></p> <p>Create artwork with recycled material</p>
